



Lynda Pauley Painting Workshop: Essentials – Putting Power into Painting

This workshop will provide essential knowledge so you can consistently turn out powerful, strikingly beautiful and engaging paintings. Using the artwork in the galleries at the Springfield Museum of Art, we will analyze paintings to better understand *why* they are good, beautiful and powerful. Morning studio time will include instructor presentation and demonstration. In the afternoon you will put into practice those skills with one-on-one instruction as students work on the essentials towards creating masterful work. We will finish with critique and invaluable peer feedback for your continued growth in putting power into painting!

Beginner thru Advanced: Some practice with your chosen painting medium is required. *This is not a workshop for first-time painters.* Contact the instructor if you have any questions about your level of experience or workshop instruction.

Schedule:

- 9:00 Introductions and brief outline of the workshop
- 9:30 Visit the Museum galleries to discuss the strengths and weaknesses in various paintings. What techniques did the artist use to draw you in? What is the painting's power?
- 10:30 Painting demos by the instructor illustrating tools and techniques discussed in the galleries
- 12:00 Lunch – Bring a lunch for eating on the Museum's beautiful grounds or you may wish to go out for lunch instead. You may also feel free to tour the galleries after your lunch.
- 1:00 Paint some power into your work – various techniques explored.
- 4:00 Clean up
- 4:15 Critique – supportive feedback for continued growth!

Lynda Pauley Painting Workshop (continued)

Supplies Needed: *Note – supplies are not available at the Museum.*

- ◆ Enough supplies in your chosen medium to complete one or two small paintings. There are no supplies available at the Museum, be sure you bring all you need.
- ◆ One or two small painting surfaces with a complete drawing and dry underpainting.* Your surface should be approximately 11x14” and ready for the day’s important work.
**Note: An underpainting is the first thin layer of paint that lays the ground work for further layers.*
- ◆ Reference for the painting you will work on, such as a photograph, sketch or other image.
- ◆ You may also need pencil and eraser, notebook or sketchbook, paint palette, rags, an odorless solvent if working in oil, apron or old shirt, etc.
